



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE MISSION COVENANT CHURCH HOLM GLAD COLLEGE

AND

CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, FRESNO, USA

This memorandum of understanding is dated October 3, 2017, and is between The Mission Covenant Church Holm Glad College, located in Hong Kong, and California State University, Fresno (hereinafter referred to as "Fresno State"), located in Fresno, California. When signed by the parties, this memorandum of understanding will evidence the mutual intent of The Mission Covenant Church Holm Glad College and Fresno State to pursue cooperation in cooperative programmes of education.

1. Objective

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to outline the possible ways in which The Mission Covenant Church Holm Glad College and Fresno State could develop and carry out collaborative education activities that are desirable, mutually beneficial, and contribute to fostering a cooperative relationship between the two entities.

2. Scope of Activities

The collaboration shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of each entity through such programs or activities as:

- Pathway program from The Mission Covenant Church Holm Glad College to Fresno State;
- Exchange activities between administrators, teachers, and students;
- Fresno State will offer qualified students from The Mission Covenant Church Holm Glad College priority admission.

3. General Principles

3.1 Regulations. Implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding will be in accordance with the Regulations of both institutions.

3.2 Costs. Except as otherwise agreed by the parties in writing, all costs incurred by each of them in connection with the preparation and negotiation of this memorandum of understanding, the definitive agreements contemplated herein, and all actions undertaken in accordance herewith, will be borne by the party incurring such costs.

3.3 Effect. This agreement is a non-binding expression of mutual intent only and is contingent on,

among other things: (i) negotiating definitive project agreements, such agreements to contain mutually satisfactory terms and conditions, (ii) the receipt of any necessary governmental consents or approvals or any material third-party consents, and (iii) securing the required public and participant funding support. Each entity will designate a coordinator to develop and implement specific activities or programs.

4. Effective Date and Length of Agreement. This Memorandum of Understanding will remain in force for a period of 5 years, subject to the availability of funds, and may be amended through the mutual agreement of both institutions. After the initial 5 year period, this Agreement may be reviewed and renewed by mutual consent every 5 years.

5. Termination. Either party reserves the right to terminate this MOU upon six months' written notice to the other.

Admission Requirements for holders of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education
(HKDSE)

GENERAL ENTRANCE REQUIREMENT:	Minimum Level 2 in 5 subjects, with at least 2 subjects at Level 3 or above. *
ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT:	1) A minimum score of 61 on the Internet Based TOEFL (iBT); or, 2) Minimum band score of 6.0 on the IELTS

*Projected HKDSE exam results may be used in the application review process. A provisional admission offer will be made with the expectation that the student will present results that meet the same level of academic performance projected in the application.

Admission by Exception:

Students who are close to meeting the minimum requirements and have principal nomination will be considered for admission.

Application Steps:

1. Complete and submit online application.
2. Submit supplemental application documents to the international admissions office via email (intladmissions@csufresno.edu) or official results may be mailed to:

3. Supplemental documents required
 - a. Copy of passport
 - b. HKDSE official results or copy of results (if copy is sent, official results must be provided to the university prior to enrollment)
 - c. TOEFL or IELTS results or copy of results (if copy is sent, official results must be provided to the university prior to enrollment)
 - d. Bank/financial statement showing required balance in excess of yearly cost estimate (US\$30,000)
